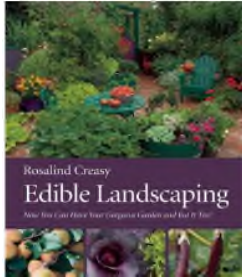

Create a Food Forest at Home

Each project is generally \$995, depending on site and project details

Buy 5 projects and get 1 free

Buy all 30 projects for \$25,000: increase the value of your property

All projects include: delivery & installation, plants, soil, materials and maintenance instructions

Annual and Seasonal Produce Production

- 1 Salad a Day Standard 4' x 8' Garden Box
- 2 Seasonal Garden Box 4' x 8': tomato in summer, greens in winter
- 3 Herb Garden Box 4' x 8'
- 4 Kid's Garden Box, 4' x 4' with plants interesting, easy and fun for kids, includes extra coaching
- 5 Mint planted in wine barrels: spearmint, chocolate mint
- 6 Mushroom Garden-shaded area needed.

Special Front Yard Projects

- 7 Edible Flowers Front Yard Border Garden – Marigolds, Pansies & Violets, Snap Dragons
- 8 Food Not Lawn Ground Cover Replacement 400 sq. ft.: chamomile or creeping rosemary or thyme, strawberry strip, or dwarf juniper
- 9 Perennial Landscape: two each of artichoke, asparagus, rhubarb, jerusalem artichoke, fennel companion planted with attractive flowers, woven into your landscaping
- 10 Herb Bushes: Integrated to frame your landscapes: rosemary, lavender, sage
- 11 Lettuce trails along pathways

Vertical and Privacy Elements

- 12 Grape or Kiwi Trellis
- 13 Fence of Berries: Raspberry, blackberry, blueberry
- 14 Vegetable Fence or Trellis: summer cucumbers, winter fava bean

Fruit Trees - Includes tree, planting and 50% off first follow-up pruning & pruning coaching

- 15 Citrus: lemon, lime, navel orange or grapefruit
- 16 Soft Fruits: avocado, fig, white sapote, expensive at the store because they are difficult to transport, but easy to eat straight from the yard
- 17 Easy Lunch Box Staples: two kinds of apples, apple-pear
- 18 Exotic: dragon fruit, passion fruit, & cherimoya
- 19 Summertime Fun: cherries & pomegranates
- 20 Fall/Winter Fruits: persimmons, pears
- 21 Nut Trees: walnut, macadamias, & almonds

Make it Super Special

- 22 Edible Flowers Scent from Heaven: integrated Hibiscus, Lilac and Honeysuckle or Jasmine

- 23 Native Edible Basics Garden: elderberry tree, poppies, hummingbird sage & aloe vera
- 24 Medicinal Tea Garden: tailored to your needs, we use Brigitte Mars, AHG recommendations
- 25 Wheat or barley grass juice "factory", outdoor tray system + set up and maintenance coaching
- 26 Wheat patch with special harvest party (see Edible Landscaping by Rosalind Creasy book)
